

# Annual Fuel Price Report 2024



The RACQ's *Annual Fuel Price Report for 2024* provides key fuel price data and analysis for 2024.

## Key Points

- At 194.5 cpl, the average retail price of regular 91 RON unleaded petrol (RULP) for Brisbane in 2024 was the highest on record, exceeding the 2023 record of 193.1 cpl by 1.4 cpl.
- Monthly and daily average RULP prices in SEQ did not match the peaks in 2022 and 2023, and daily and monthly average diesel prices fell short of the records from 2022.
- The increased average price for RULP in Brisbane reflected an increase in retail margins and fuel excise as well as the modest increase in the average oil price.
- The average indicative retail margin for RULP sold in Brisbane for 2024, at 21.4 cpl, was 4.1 cpl higher than 2023, and 7.4 cpl higher than in 2022.
- Indicative refinery margins, at 12.2 cpl, were lower than in 2022 and 2023, reflecting a reduction in Singapore benchmark prices for refined fuel relative to the oil price.
- The sum of indicative retail, wholesale and refiner margins on RULP sold in Brisbane in 2024 was 40.8 cpl, a reduction of 1.2 cpl from 2023 (at 42.0 cpl) as the reduced refining margin outweighed the increased retail margin.
- RULP sold in Brisbane (at 194.5 cpl) was the most expensive of all capital cities, followed by Canberra at 193.2 cpl. Perth was the cheapest capital at 181.1 cpl, 13.4 cpl cheaper than Brisbane.
- Dalby was the cheapest centre to buy RULP in Queensland in 2024, at 175.6 cpl, followed by Gladstone and Bundaberg both at 176.7 cpl.
- The average price of diesel in Brisbane in 2024 was 193.6 cpl, 10.0 cpl lower than 2023. Indicative retail margins, at 17.6 cpl, were 1.4 cpl lower than 2023.
- Indicative refinery margins for diesel, at 15.2 cpl, eased compared to 2023 (25.3 cpl) reflecting a reduction in the benchmark diesel prices in Singapore (GASOIL).
- At 193.6 cpl, diesel sold in Brisbane in 2024 was the most expensive of the five largest capital cities. Only the smaller capitals were more expensive. Adelaide was the cheapest at 186.5 cpl (7.1 cpl less than Brisbane) and Canberra was the dearest at 200.1 cpl (6.5 cpl more than Brisbane).
- Miles was the cheapest place to buy diesel in Queensland in 2024, with an average price of 181.8 cpl.
- Looking forward to 2025, oil prices and retail fuel prices are likely to be lower on average than in 2024, with Brent oil prices expected to average US\$ 75 per barrel (lower than in 2024, when the average was US\$ 83.8).

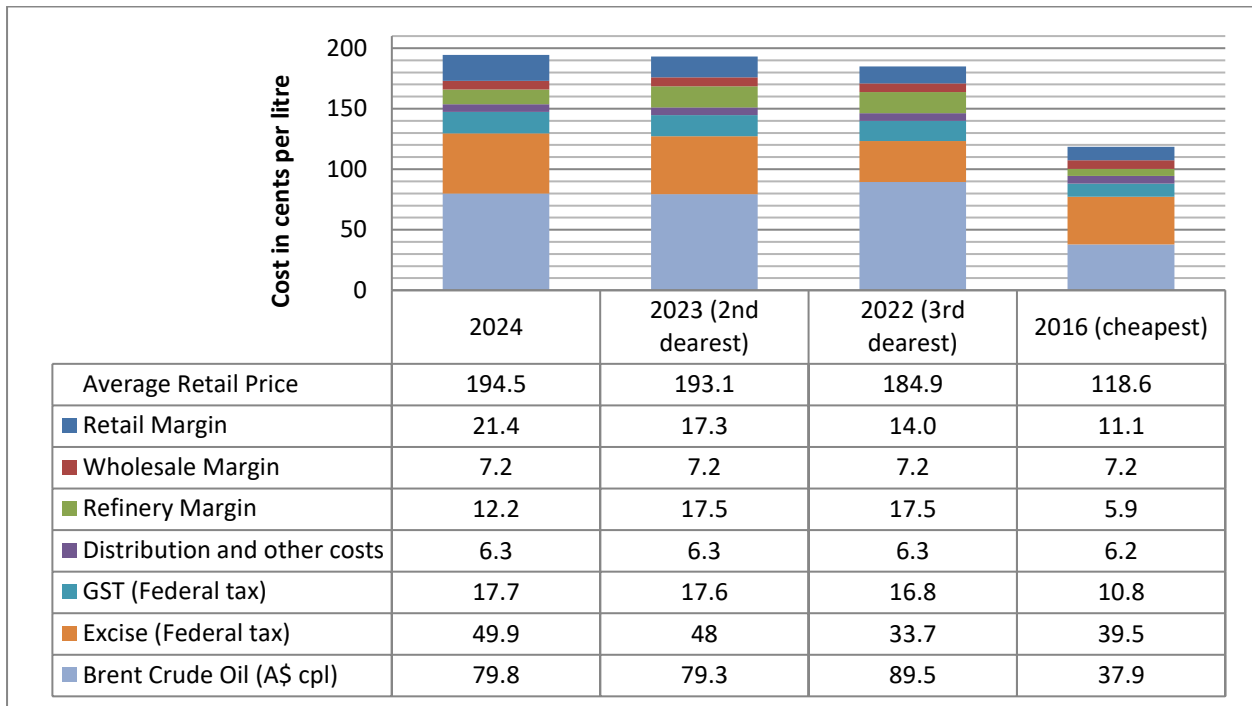

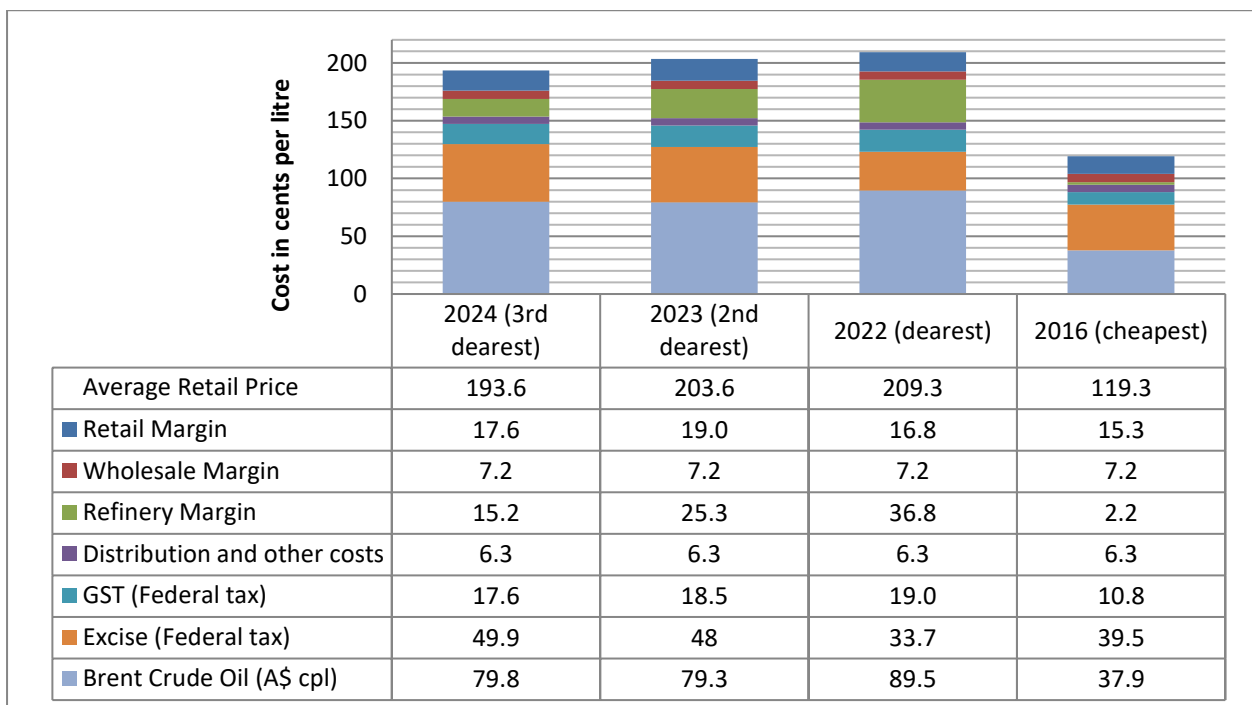
## RULP Price Breakdown

The figure below presents a price breakdown for RULP sold in Brisbane in 2024, 2023 and 2022 (the dearest, second dearest and third dearest years in the last ten years), and 2016 (the cheapest year in the last ten years).



## Diesel Price Breakdown

The figure below presents a price breakdown for diesel sold in Brisbane in 2024 (the third dearest year in the last ten years) 2023 (last year and the second dearest year), 2022 (last year and dearest), and 2016 (the cheapest year in the last ten years).



## International Benchmark Prices

Oil and petrol are traded globally in very high volumes. Therefore, Australia is a price taker for all automotive fuels. The Terminal Gate Price (TGP) - the key wholesale price for all liquid automotive fuels in the Australian market - is strongly correlated to Singapore wholesale/benchmark prices and oil prices. For RULP the refined product benchmark is Singapore MOGAS and for diesel the benchmark is Singapore GASOIL.

The table below summarises the annual average prices of the Singapore benchmarks – MOGAS and GASOIL, Brent crude oil for Asia-Pacific delivery and the A\$/US\$ exchange rate.

The average price for Brent crude oil (Asia-Pac) in 2024 was AU\$ 126.5 per barrel (US\$ 83.8 per barrel), largely unchanged from 2023. The fluctuations in the monthly average prices observed during 2024 were less than 2023. The lowest average monthly price was AU\$ 117.8 in January 2024, and the highest was AU\$ 135.6 in April 2024. From the high point in April, oil prices fell steadily to low point of AU\$ 124.5 in October, before strengthening in the last couple of months before ending 2024 with an average of AU\$ 130.2 observed in December 2024.

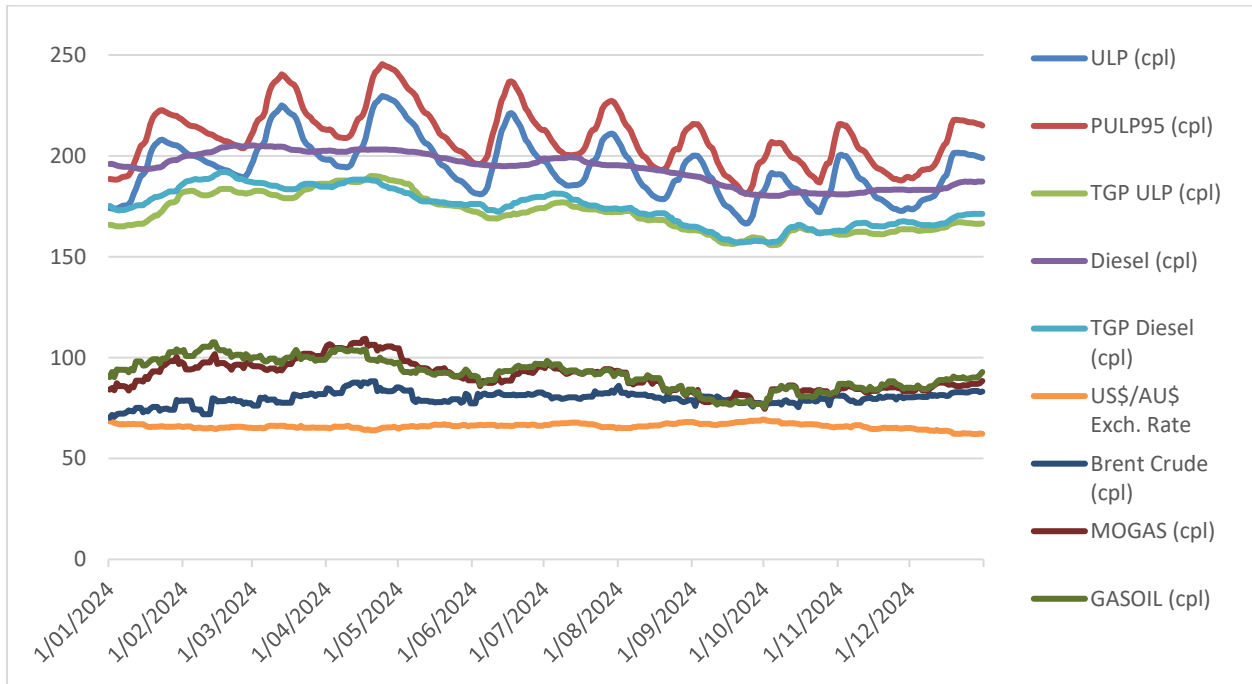
As supply constriction eased in the Asia-Pacific region the Singapore Benchmark for ULP and Diesel both fell. A moderate fall was observed in MOGAS the Singapore benchmark price for ULP. However, a substantial fall was observed for GASOIL (the Diesel benchmark). Singapore GASOIL in 2024, at 141.0 AU\$/bbl was down by almost AU\$ 20 compared to the 2023 average.

The factors affecting crude oil prices included: the on-going impacts of conflicts in oil producing regions, including the Russia and Ukraine conflict and Middle East conflicts, the impact of increased interest rates on economic growth or reduced growth expectations especially in China (the world's largest energy consumer), decisions by OPEC member countries (which account for 40% of world oil production) to maintain restrictions on production volumes, and an increased US oil production. US crude oil production increased from 12.9 million barrels per day in 2023 to an estimated 13.2 million barrels per

day in 2024. The increase in US production limited the impact of OPEC+ production cuts by meeting the demand that would have otherwise been supplied by OPEC sources.

The Singapore benchmark prices for refined fuels rose in the early months of 2024, before falling back from the second quarter of the year. The gap between wholesale prices for petrol and diesel fuel which had persisted in 2022 and 2023 was nearly eliminated in 2024, as the Singapore benchmark prices for unleaded petrol (MOGAS) and diesel fuel (GASOIL) converged. The figure below displays the price trends for the Brent crude oil price, the Singapore MOGAS and GASOIL prices, the average Brisbane TGP, the Brisbane retail price for RULP and diesel, and the AU\$/US\$ exchange rate.

The latest forecasts for the average value of Brent crude oil in 2025 by market analysts and the US Energy Information Administration suggest that the price would drop to around \$US 75 per barrel, lower than the average in 2024. Factors affecting crude oil prices in 2025 include an expected peak in China’s oil demand, continued growth in demand from India and Europe, and an expected increase in OPEC’s production starting in April 2025. The OPEC production increase will only proceed if prices are high enough to make higher production profitable.

During the year, prices are likely to fluctuate around the expected average due to seasonal changes in oil demand and any disruptions to supply during the year.

### Price Records

While 2024 saw a new annual record high ULP price for Greater Brisbane, prices were more stable in 2024 compared to 2023 and the monthly and daily records observed in 2023 remained intact. A record high daily average RULP price of 232.4 cpl was observed in Brisbane on 5 October 2023. Prior to 2023, the previous record was 221.4 cpl, observed on 20 June 2022.

The record high the monthly average price of 214.4 cpl for Brisbane, observed in October 2023, was not exceeded in 2024. The previous (pre-2023) record high of 205.9 cpl was observed in June 2022.

New record high annual average RULP prices were observed in many centres, including Ipswich, Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast, Atherton, Biloela, Blackwater, Childers, Emerald, Longreach, Mareeba, Moranbah, Mount Isa, Nambour, Noosa, Roma, and Whitsunday. In all other centres the record high observed in 2023 or 2022 was not exceeded.

No new record high diesel prices were observed in 2024 (annual, monthly or daily). The record high diesel prices predominantly observed in 2022, and the three records observed in 2023, remain the highest on record.

The tables below present a summary of the record high prices observed in Queensland (new records are highlighted in bold and italics). These records are only for centres surveyed by RACQ. Prices in other centres may have exceeded the prices presented below.

## Regional Queensland

With an average RULP price of 175.6 cpl, Dalby was the cheapest place to buy RULP in Queensland in 2024 (as it was in 2023), followed by Bundaberg and Gladstone both at 176.7 cpl (Bundaberg was the cheapest in 2022 and 2021). The Dalby average RULP price was 18.9 cpl lower than the average price of 194.5 cpl in Brisbane. Goondiwindi, Miles, Beaudesert, Hervey Bay, Maryborough, Warwick, Gympie, Whitsunday, Cairns, Kingaroy, Rockhampton, Townsville, Yeppoon, Mackay, Ingham, Lockyer Valley, Bowen, Innisfail, Somerset, Toowoomba, Nambour, Biloela, Moranbah, Sunshine Coast, Tully, Gold Coast, Mareeba, Charters Towers, Atherton, Childers, Roma, and Ipswich were also cheaper than Brisbane. Longreach, with an average RULP price of 214.9 cpl, retained the position as the most expensive regional centre<sup>3</sup>. Longreach has held the dubious honour of most expensive centre since 2018.

Like in 2023 and 2022, Miles had the cheapest diesel in Queensland in 2024 at an average of 181.8 cpl, 11.8 cpl cheaper than the Brisbane price of 193.6 cpl. Gladstone, Dalby, Warwick, Whitsunday, Gympie, Maryborough, Beaudesert, Bowen, Lockyer Valley, Goondiwindi, Toowoomba, Somerset, Hervey Bay, Roma, Bundaberg, Cairns, Nambour, Townsville, Yeppoon, Ipswich, Childers, Sunshine Coast, and Mackay were also cheaper than Brisbane. Like with RULP, Longreach, with an average diesel price of 207.5 cpl, was the most expensive centre in Queensland<sup>3</sup>.

The tables in Appendix 1 display the average retail price and average indicative retail margin for RULP and diesel in major Queensland cities and towns, and interstate capitals.

## Cheap and Expensive Suburbs and Sites

The analysis in Appendix 2 presents the top ten cheapest and dearest suburbs and retail sites in SEQ, and the top five for the individual LGAs, for Regular ULP for the 2024 in SEQ.

## Data Sources

All data presented in this report is RACQ work derived from calculations based on data primarily from OPIS, with some additional data from Informed Sources and the Reserve Bank of Australia. The data presented in the report is the best available data at the time of publication. The data presented in this report supersedes all previous reports.

## Appendix 2: Cheap and Expensive Suburbs and Sites in SEQ

The section presents the top ten cheapest and dearest suburbs and retail sites in SEQ, and the top five for the individual LGAs, for Regular ULP for the 2024 in SEQ.

While these are the cheapest and dearest sites on average for the whole year, on any given day other sites may have been more or less expensive. This analysis includes all sites in the mainland metropolitan areas of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, Redland Bay, and Moreton Bay, as well as Sunshine Coast and Gold Coast. Sites outside these areas were excluded from this analysis. Sites on islands were excluded, e.g., the sites on Minjeeribah/Stradbroke Island. Sites in rural locations were also excluded, e.g., the sites in Harlin, Aratula, and similar locations.

Only sites that traded and reported prices for most of 2024 were included in this analysis. For example, the new BP site in Helensvale, is on average one of the cheapest sites on the Gold Coast, but only opened in December 2024 and was therefore excluded from this analysis.

These analyses are for 100% mineral Regular 91RON ULP only. E10, PULP95, PULP98 and Diesel prices are not included in these analyses.
